



A&C Program – Term 2, 2024
Tuesday 30th April (Week 1) – Friday 5th July (Week 10)

The Beecroft P&C Arts and Crafts program offers opportunities for children to learn a variety of new skills after school. Our classes run Monday to Friday from 3.30pm-5pm with teachers who are engaged to instruct children in their areas of expertise.

Teachers are engaged to run individual courses on the understanding that enrolled students:

- Attend willingly.
- Are interested in the subject matter covered.
- Respect their fellow students and their teachers.
- Do not leave the classroom until permission has been granted.

Enrolment details

- Arts & Crafts enrolments open on Friday 15th March 2024 at 9pm. Enrolments will close on Friday 29th March 2024 at 9pm.
- Kindergarten students cannot enrol for Term 2.
- Enrolments are via Qkr! only. Please ensure you receive a receipt to confirm enrolment.
- A cancellation fee of \$20 per enrolled class will apply once enrolment closes.
- A minimum of 5 students is required for the class to commence. If the class cannot commence, parents will be notified, and a full refund will be issued.
- Classes are filled on a first come first served basis via Qkr!
- No refunds will be given after the 30th of April.
- If your child has a healthcare plan, please ensure that permission is granted via Qkr! for A&C to access a copy of the plan from the BPS school office.
- Beecroft Public School and the P&C have the authority to review all enrolments.

After School Procedure

- After school finishes, students are to meet at the Canteen, where the A&C teachers will mark a roll and take them to the classroom.
- We recommend that your child brings afternoon tea.
- If your child is unwell or not able to attend their A&C class, please text Sabrina (A&C Coordinator) on 0494 711 788.

Pickup Procedure

- All children must be collected by a parent/carer by 5pm.
- When A&C classes finish, parent/carers (over 18) must sign out and collect their child from the classroom.
- If your child is enrolled in BOOSH after A&C, they will be taken to BOOSH and signed in by our staff. You will then need to pick up your child from BOOSH.
- From 2024, late pickups will incur a late fee.
- If your child is picked up after 5.10pm, you will be issued a \$20 late fee. An additional \$20 will be charged for pickup after 5.30pm.
- An invoice will be issued and late fees will be paid via Qkr!
