The Beecroft P&C Arts and Crafts program provides opportunities for children to develop new skills after school. Classes run Monday to Friday from 3:30 pm to 5:00 pm, with experienced teachers leading lessons in their areas of expertise.

Important Guidelines for Enrolled Students:

Teachers are engaged to run individual courses with the understanding that students must:

- Attend willingly and actively participate in their enrolled class.
- Respect their fellow students and teachers.
- Remain in the classroom until signed out by a parent/carer.

Enrolment Details:

- Enrolments open: Friday, 21 March 2025, at 9:00 pm.
- Enrolments close: Friday, 4 April 2025, at 9:00 pm.
- Enrolments are via Qkr! app, on a first-come, first-served basis.

Key Points:

- No refunds will be issued once classes commence.
- A \$20 cancellation fee per enrolled class applies after enrolment closes.
- If your child has a healthcare plan, please provide permission via Qkr! for A&C to access the plan from the BPS school office.
- Beecroft Public School and the P&C reserve the right to review all enrolments.

After-School Procedure:

- After school, students should meet at the Canteen, where A&C teachers will mark the roll and escort them to the classroom.
- We recommend packing afternoon tea for your child.

Pickup Procedure:

- All children must be collected by a parent/carer by 5:00 pm.
- A parent/carer (18 or older) must sign out and collect the child from the classroom.
- Students enrolled in BOOSH after A&C will be taken there and signed in by staff; you will then collect your child from BOOSH.

Late Pickup Fees:

- Pickup after 5:10 pm incurs a \$20 late fee.
- Pickup after 5:30 pm incurs an additional \$20 charge.
- An invoice will be issued, and late fees must be paid via Qkr!
