Enrolment Details

* Arts & Craft Enrolments **open on Friday 17th March 2023 @ 9pm** and will **close on 31st March 2023. No late enrolments will be accepted.**

* A cancellation fee of \$20 per enrolled class will apply after enrolment closes.

* Enrolments are via **Qkr! only**, please ensure you have received a Qkr! receipt to confirm enrolment.

* Classes have a maximum number of 18 Students. A minimum of 5 students is required for the class to commence, if the class can't commence, then parents will be notified and a full refund will be issued.

* Year 1 to Year 6 students are invited to enroll in Term 2 A&C program.

* Classes are filled on a first come first served basis via Qkr!

* Please note that 'No Refunds' will be given once classes have started from Wednesday 29 April 2023.

* If your child has a **Healthcare Plan**, please ensure that permission is granted in Qkr! for Arts & Craft to access a copy of the plan from the Beecroft Public School Office.

*Beecroft Public School P&C have the authority to review enrolments

Procedures

*After School finishes, students are to meet at the **Canteen**, the Arts & Craft teachers will pick them up and take them to the classroom

*When Arts & Craft classes finish, the students should be picked up from **Mary Street Gate** and signed out by their parent/carer over 18 years

*If your children have enrolled in BOOSH after A&C, our staff will take them to BOOSH directly and sign them in. You would need to pick up your kids from BOOSH afterwards.

*All classes run from 3:30pm to 5.00pm.

***If your child is unwell or not able to attend their Art & Craft class, please text Sabrina (Arts & Craft Coordinator) on 0404 322 780, so that they are marked off the roll.**

*** Should your child have a 'positive covid test result', please do not attend the A&C Program.** Please contact us and upon proof of result, we may arrange a lesson refund at the end of term.

- From 5.15pm to 5.30pm - \$20.00 fee
- Subsequently, \$20.00 per 15 minutes will apply thereafter
