- Never leave the activity area without permission.
- Respectfully listen to and follow teachers' and instructors' guidelines.
- Respect male and female areas. Enter no room other than your own.
- Respect the environment. Do not attempt to pat the wildlife.
- No pocket knives, glass, valuables, **mobile phones or devices, including smart watches** to be taken.
- All accidents or damage must be reported. Willful damage will be paid for by the individual/s responsible.
- No vending machines are to be used.
- No lollies, chewing gum or food to be brought on the excursion.
- Respect others after lights out. There should be no need to leave your rooms after 'lights out'.
- To avoid accidents, do not run around accommodation areas.
- Be aware that you are representing Beecroft Public School at all times.
- Always behave in a courteous and respectful manner, especially in public venues.
