



Excursion: Stage 2 Science – Living World: Kalkari Track

Dear Parents/Carers,

In Term 2, Stage 2 students are studying the Science unit 'Living World'. During a visit to the Kalkari Visitors Centre in the Ku-ringgai Chase National Park, followed by a bushwalk along the Kalkari Track to Bobbin Head, students will engage in several hands-on learning activities to observe different plants and animals and use these features to classify them into groups. They will also learn about the interconnected nature of traditional Aboriginal people and the land.

Students will leave Beecroft Public School at 9am and return to school at 3pm.
