



Excursion: Stage 2 Science – Living World: Kalkari Track

Dear Parents/Carers,

In Term 2, Stage 2 students are studying the Science unit 'Living World'. During a visit to the Kalkari Visitors Centre in the Ku-ring-gai Chase National Park, followed by a bushwalk along the Kalkari Track to Bobbin Head, students will engage in several hands-on learning activities to observe different plants and animals and use these features to classify them into groups. They will also learn about the interconnected nature of traditional Aboriginal people and the land.

To: Kalkari / Bobbin Head (Gibberagong Environmental Education Centre)

When: Tuesday 30th April – 4B, 4C & 4L

Friday 3rd May – 3B, 3S & 3N

Monday 13th May – 3/4J & 4F

Cost: \$26 (on Semester 1 account)

Travel: Bus

Students will leave Beecroft Public School at 9am and return to school at 3pm.

Supervising Teachers: Gibberagong Environmental Education Centre staff and class teachers

Uniform: Beecroft PS sports uniform, including hat, sunscreen and sports shoes.

Bring: A small backpack to carry belongings, including:

- A water bottle containing at least 750mL water.
- Food (see below).

Food: Students are required to bring their own recess and lunch on the day. All rubbish will be taken home by students so an earth-friendly lunch is recommended in order to minimise packaging. Food supplied for this excursion should be in line with the **Beecroft Public School Anaphylaxis Policy**, which asks students and parents not to bring any foods containing nut products.

This excursion has the approval of the Principal. A risk management plan has been submitted as a part of the excursion planning.
